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Glove material

- High performance Polyethylene yarn combined with glass fiber wrapped by Polyester and Spandex (Liner material)

Possible Harmful ingredientsSensitizers

- Natural rubber proteins (in knitwrist elastic)

Only a very small number of users may be sensitised to this ingredient in the glove and hence may develop irritant and/or allergic contact reactions.
